

Paint Lake Community Website

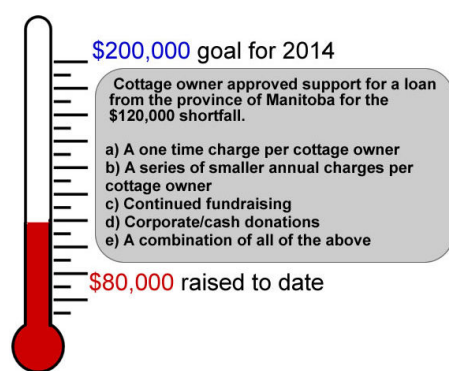
The Paint Lake Cottage Owners Association (PLCOA) has launched a new website! This is the “go to” site for anything related to the community of Paint Lake.

The “Members Only” area is open to all PLCOA members who are Liz Lake, Paint Lake and remote cottage owners. PLCOA membership allows you to vote at the AGM, as well as register and receive early bird discounts to all Paint Lake community events. **We strongly encourage all cottage owners to visit the website, www.paintlakecommunity.ca and join the PLCOA. The site will be live on June 7, 2014.**

Fire Hall Expansion/Community Centre (Vote on FINANCING PLAN)

The community of Paint Lake has outgrown it’s existing fire hall. Plans for an expansion are in place; including the construction of a new three-bay building and the conversion of the existing structure into a training-facility/ community centre. The proposed budget for the expansion is \$200,000. To date, more than \$80,000 has been raised through joint PLCOA-PLVFD fundraising efforts; there remains, however, a \$120,000 shortfall. If sufficient funds can be raised, construction could start as early as September 2014.

The joint PLCOA-PLVFD building committee is hosting an **information session on June 10, 2014** to outline the options for a proposed financing plan. This plan involves a loan from the Province of Manitoba for the \$120,000 shortfall and requires the support of the land-based cottage owners. Repayment options include a one-time charge or a series of



smaller charges to the park district fees for every land-based cottage owner, continued fundraising and corporate/ cash donations. All cottage owners are strongly encouraged to attend this information session; to ask questions, bring up concerns and have questions answered. Information from this session will be made available on the website shortly thereafter. A vote for all land-based cottage owners will be held on July 16, 2014 to gauge support for the financing plan.

The Proposal FINANCING PLAN

Cottage owner approved support for a loan from the province of Manitoba for the \$120,000 shortfall.

Pay back options include:

- a) A one time charge per cottage owner
- b) A series of smaller annual charges per cottage owner
- c) Continued fundraising
- d) Corporate/cash donations
- e) A combination of all of the above
