

Work in Manitoba's provincial parks as a Parks Operator

Manitoba Parks is looking for self driven and outgoing individuals with a keen eye for details, a love of the outdoors and a passion for working with people.

Park Operators are responsible for the day to day operation of maintenance equipment for the campground and public use areas in provincial parks. Ensuring park visitors have an enjoyable experience is always top of mind of a Parks Operator.

As a Parks Operator you will be required to operate, riding mowers, dump trucks, skid steer and sewage pump truck as required. You will operate hand tools and power equipment (chain saw) to perform general ground maintenance duties. Other duties are painting, garbage and fish offal pick up and disposal, and some building maintenance projects.

Essential Qualifications:

- Experience in the operation of parks related equipment such as 1 ton dump trucks, ride on lawn mowers, skid steers, sewage pumper truck.
- Experience in the operation of hand held powered equipment such as chain saws
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision

Desired Qualifications:

- Knowledge of safe work practices
- Experience in ground maintenance
- Experience in building maintenance

Conditions of Employment:

- Must be legally entitled to work in Canada.
- Must possess and maintain a valid full stage Manitoba Class 5 (or better) driver's license and provide a Driver's Abstract.
- Must be physically able to perform the duties assigned to the position including working outdoors, lifting approximately 50 lbs in weight and sitting, standing and bending.
- Must be willing and able to work weekends, statutory holidays.
